

A Special Meeting of the Otsego City Commission was held Tuesday, September 26, 2017.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Trobeck at 5:00 p.m. with the following Commissioners present: Nick Breedveld, Tom Gilmer, Jim Misner and Stacey Withee. Absent: None.

The audience joined the Commission in the Pledge of Allegiance.

I. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. DISCUSSION WITH MML – CITY MANAGER SEARCH

Kathie Grinzinger from the MML was present and reviewed the hiring process with the Commission. She indicated that beginning today, the process will take up to four months, and possibly an additional month, if you factor in that the new hire would have to give notice to a current employer.

Ms. Grinzinger stated that she had previously met with the Stakeholder Group and Department Heads earlier in the day. She commented that the Stakeholder Group indicated that they would like to have a meet and greet with the candidates before the interviews. It was the consensus of the Commission that a meet and greet should be held.
